

MONASTERY DINING TABLE

Inspired by the classic refectory tables that were used for dining in monasteries during Medieval times. Refectory tables later became popular banqueting tables in castles and other noble residences, where their sturdy stature and long rectangular shape could accommodate abundant feasts. The timber frame is handcrafted in century-old reclaimed oak, using enduring mortise and tenon joinery, a technique that has been used in woodworking for thousands of years. A cool and crisp marble top contrasts with the warmth of the rugged timber beneath and offers an elegant platform for modern entertaining.
